

You may be able to combine any of our packages (e.g. Regular appointment package, Longitudinal Package, International Student Package, etc) with an **Interview and/or Admission Guarantee**. We are so confident in our services that you will receive a refund if you have met all the terms and conditions in your package and do not receive at least one medical school interview invite and/or offer of admission over the timeframe stipulated in your package.

The following two cases illustrate how a Regular package works with an Interview or Admission Guarantee:

Case 1

Katie is a 3rd year undergraduate student at McMaster University whose goal is to gain acceptance into a US or Canadian medical school. She enrolls in a Regular 10 appointment package that comes with a US or Canadian medical school Interview Guarantee. She enrolls in February of her 3rd year and is paired with 1 US consultant and 1 Canadian consultant. Her package includes the following:

US application preparation (6 hours)

- 1) Critical feedback on previous application(s) including personal statements and secondaries, identification of areas for improvement this application cycle, school selection based on initial application review, and referee selection (90 minutes)
- 2) Personal statement preparation and first draft review (60 minutes)
- 3) Personal statement second draft review (30 minutes)
- 4) AMCAS activities section preparation and review (45 minutes)
- 5) Final application review and preparation for submission: school selection, personal statement, activities section, etc (45 minutes)
- 6) Secondary essay review (90 minutes)

Canadian application preparation (4 hours)

- 1) Critical feedback on previous application(s) including personal statements, identification of areas for improvement this application cycle, school selection based on initial application review, and referee selection (60 minutes)
- 2) Personal statement preparation and first draft review (60 minutes)
- 3) Personal statement second draft review (30 minutes)
- 4) OMSAS activities section preparation and review (45 minutes)
- 5) Final application review and preparation for submission: school selection, personal statement, activities section, etc (45 minutes)

Result: Katie received 3 US and 4 Canadian medical school interviews.

Case 2

Katie is now is in her 4th year and has 3 US and 4 Canadian medical school interviews. She enrolls in a Regular 11 appointment package that comes with a US or Canadian medical school Admission Guarantee. She enrolls in February of her 4th year and is paired with 2 US consultants and 3 Canadian consultants. Where possible, she is assigned to consultants who have either been interviewed at or accepted to the very same 7 schools. Her package now includes the following:

US interview preparation (4 hours)

- 1) A 1:1 “Introduction to the US medical school interview session” by one of her consultants (60 minutes)
- 2) Mock interview tailored to the format of US school #1 (60 minutes)
- 3) Mock interview tailored to the format of US school #2 (60 minutes)
- 4) Mock interview tailored to the format of US school #3 (60 minutes)

Canadian interview preparation (7 hours)

- 1) Participation in our group “4 hour Interview crash course” (credited as 120 minutes)
- 2) Mock MMI tailored to the format of Canadian school #1 (90 minutes)
- 3) Mock interview tailored to the format of Canadian school #2 (60 minutes)
- 4) Mock interview tailored to the format of Canadian school #3 (60 minutes)
- 5) Mock MMI tailored to the format of Canadian school #4 (90 minutes)

Result: Katie received 2 US and 2 Canadian medical school acceptances.

Notes:

- Final decisions on the amount of time to spend on each application component will be left to you and your assigned consultant(s). If there is any disagreement, MDconsultants Consulting Corp. will arbitrate.
- Our consultants will get to know your application very well given the extended time they will spend on it. Consultants are usually happy to answer basic emails outside of designated appointments so that your application can keep moving along. The time spent answering emails (as well as initially getting to know your application) is not directly billable to you. This of course does not include any designated appointments conducted primarily via email e.g. personal statement feedback. We do ask, however, that you save major questions for designated appointments.
- Determination of student fit for Interview and/or Admission Guarantee packages is solely at the discretion of MDconsultants Consulting Corp. and pricing on packages varies depending on each student’s needs and career goals.

Documents required

We require the following information to determine whether we can offer an Interview and/or Admission Guarantee:

- 1) A list of all the schools (US and/or Canadian) that you are applying to this application cycle and your GPA calculated specific to each school
- 2) MCAT score
- 3) Unofficial transcripts, and list of annual GPA for each year of undergraduate and/or graduate studies as well as cumulative GPA (this may already be indicated on your transcript)
- 4) A CV
- 5) A blurb on what you perceive to be the weakest aspect of your application

Refund criteria

If you have met all the terms and conditions in your package and do not receive at least one medical school interview invite and/or offer of admission over the timeframe stipulated in your package, you may qualify for a refund. For refunds to be processed, you must submit proof of all grades obtained during your undergraduate and/or graduate studies (in the form of official transcripts), evidence of application to all schools mutually agreed upon by you and your consultant(s), and documented rejections from the above stated schools.
